Included in this file are all of the directions you will need to create this learning game. It is formatted to fit on a plastic pencil case like you might find at the dollar store, but an envelope works well too.


You will need: a dry erase marker, laminator, and small pom poms (or other small pieces).

Steps:

- 1. Print out all pages single-sided and cut out all boxes on outer lines.
- 2. Laminate items, affix labels to box. You may choose to laminate similar words back to back.
- 3. Put directions, info page, and other materials into your box or envelope.
- 4. Have lots of fun!






- Use pom-poms to "trace" the sight word.

- For extra fine motor practice, use the tweezers to pick up the pom-poms.































