# GETTING KINDLE BOOKS THROUGH LIBBY



The Libby app is <u>not</u> available for Kindle e-readers. In order to get library books on a Kindle e-reader (ex. Kindle, Paperwhite and Oasis), you will need to access Libby on a separate device, then send the e-books over WiFi (or via USB) to your Kindle device using these instructions.

Install the Libby app (iOS or Android) OR go to <a href="https://ohdbks.overdrive.com/">https://ohdbks.overdrive.com/</a> through a browser to access the Ohio Digital Library.

## **Using the Libby App:**

- Once installed, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with your card number and pin.
- If you plan on sending ebooks from this device to your Kindle frequently, you can change your preference for books to **Read With Kindle**.
  - Tap \_\_\_\_\_\_.
     Tap Settings, then Read Books With....
     Tap Kindle or Libby to open books that way by default, or tap I Have No Preference to choose how you open a book each time.

 Browse for an ebook to borrow. When you search for ebooks, you can change the preferences to find Kindle supported titles. Under Preferences, choose Supports and change to Kindle (this preference will remain saved unless you change it again). Once you've borrowed a title, it will show up in your Loans on your Shelf.



2. Tap loans at the top of the screen.



- 3. Tap Read With...
- 4. Tap Kindle.
- 5. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to finish getting the book.
  - If you're signed into your Amazon account, verify the "Deliver to:" device and tap Get Library Book.
  - If you're not signed into your Amazon account, tap Get Library Book, and sign in.

### Using a Browser:

- Access The Ohio Digital Library at <a href="https://ohdbks.overdrive.com/">https://ohdbks.overdrive.com/</a>. (This is the same as what you would access in the Libby app.)
- Click on **Sign In**. Choose **Delaware County District Library** and sign in with your card and pin number.
- You can change your reading preference by clicking on **Settings** and check the box marked **Kindle Preference**.



 Browse or search for an ebook to borrow. The website does offer a Kindle Books section at the top left of the screen. You can also search for a title and limit it to Kindle Book under **Ebooks** on the left side of the screen.
 Once you've borrowed a title, you can access your **Loans** under the books icon or under **My Account**.



Choose Read Now with Kindle. You will then be prompted to sign in to your Amazon account. From there you
will choose Get Library Book and select your Kindle device to send it to. You will need a WiFi connection (or
USB cable) to send to your Kindle.



# Returning Kindle books:

- Ebooks will be automatically returned after the loan period expires but you may return them early.
- In the Libby app: Choose Manage Loan next to the cover of the ebook. Choose Return Early.
- In the browser: There will be a **Return** icon below the cover of the ebook.
- You can also return Kindle ebooks through Amazon. Log in and go to Your Account on Amazon.
   Then choose Manage Your Content and Devices. Find the title in your books and choose Return this book.

#### Why can't I send a book to Kindle?

- The ebook may not be available in that format.
- You may have already downloaded the ebook in a different format through the Libby app or through the browser.
   You would need to borrow the item again in order to send it to your Kindle.
